



SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- · Li-ion batteries can be dangerous when used wrong, short circuit or wrong usage can lead to fire or an explosion
- · Do not put the battery in a charger or equipment with wrong terminals connected
- · Never short out the battery. Take care you don't short out it accidentally for example, do not put it in your pocket together with keys
- · Do not disassemble or deform the battery. Dispose it if the battery is deformed
- · Do not immerse in water
- Avoid excessive physical shock or vibration
- · Do not expose to, dispose of the battery in fire
- · Keep out of the reach of children
- · Never use a modified or damaged charger
- · Do not leave battery in charger over 12 hours
- · Store the battery in a cool, dry and well-ventilated area
- · Dispose of in accordance with local regulations
- · Do not solder on these cells
